(CA Gov. Code §8206)

    - 3. type of ID
    - 4. ID's issuing agency
    - 5. ID's number

## VII. Right thumbprint, if power of attorney or document affecting real property

- \* The statute does not prescribe separate journal records for each document when multiple documents are notarized for the same signer at the same time: as long as the above requirements are met, a single journal record may be used in such cases.
- \*\* The statute does not prescribe the names of the signers or the credible witnesses to be recorded in the journal; however, with the names omitted, it will be impossible to identify who signed the journal's records.
